## Welcome back

We hope you have all had a wonderful Easter break and we look forward to an exciting new term.

## Theme - Marvellous Minibeasts

Our theme this term is 'Marvellous Minibeasts.' We will be learning all about minibeasts and their lifecyles. We will also enjoy spotting minibeasts around the school in their different habitats.

## Reading

Please continue to read regularly with your child (at least $3 x$ per week) and write in their yellow reading diaries. Remember sharing a story is equally as important as children reading to you and we recommend that you engage with each book multiple times as this supports overall fluency and comprehension. We continue to have an increased access to Oxford Owls which provides you with further phonetically aligned reading books. Please do contact your child's class teacher if you need any support with selecting books for your child.

## Year 2 SATS

This term the majority of Year $2 s$ will be sitting the 'Statutory Attainment Tests' (SATs). All families were sent further information about this via email just before the Easter break. We run these as 'quizzes' and have previously found children enjoy taking part in them. There is more information about this on our website under the KS1 tab.

## Year 1 Phonics Screening Check

Mrs Upham will be providing a video explaining a little about the Phonics Screening Check which will take place in Term 6. During this, Year 1 children (and Year 2 children retaking) will sit a statutory Phonics test. Individually they will read a set of 40 decodable words to a familiar adult. The 40 words will consist of real and 'alien' words. 'Alien words' are words which are decodable but are not real, they are accompanied by a picture of an alien. An example of words in the Phonics Screening Check are below.


## Clothing

As the weather starts to warm up we understand that sometimes coats sometimes may not be brought to school. Please ensure that your child has appropriate clothing in school as we go outside at playtime in all weathers. Please ensure clothes have a clear name label in them.
