

Literacy

Hand writing using pre-cursive script and sitting letters on the line. Ensuring letters descend and ascend correctly

SPAG (spelling, punctuation and grammar)
Focusing on three tick sentence, including: capital letter, finger space and full stops. Using phonics knowledge to spell words how they sound
Adding -ed on the end of words to indicate past tense
Using 'and' to join two ideas together
Spelling Year 1 Common Exception Words correctly individually and in our writing
Using a question mark correctly when writing question sentences

Science

Everyday Materials:

- Identify and name a variety of everyday materials
- Distinguish between an object and the material from which it's made
- Describe the physical properties of a variety of everyday materials
- Compare and group together a variety of materials based on their properties.

Numeracy

Counting: Count on and back within 20 from any starting point. Count in 2s, 5s and 10s. One more and one less. Read and write numbers to 20 in numerals and in words to 10.

Place Value: The meaning of tens and ones
Addition and subtraction adding and subtracting numbers within 20 including 0. The meaning of the equals sign.

Geometry ~ Shape: Recognise and name common 2D and 3D shapes.
