- Complete a sketch of your favourite invention
- Compare recent and historical inventions
- Use junk modelling to build your own invention
- Build your own suspension bridge like *Isambard Kingdom Brunel*
- Research Inventors or inventions from around the world
- Become a chef and invent your own recipe for a tasty snack or smoothie!
- Adapt and improve a household/school object
- Any other idea you have!
