Theme - The Great Fire of London

Our theme this term will be 'The Great Fire of London.
As part of the topic we will be learning about life in the past,



including the significance of Samuel Pepys and his diary. This will help us think about sources of information in history. We will also be creating art work as we observe tudor houses and understand a little more about why the fire spread so quickly and also recognising how life has changed drastically between then and present day. This is a really exciting topic that we are sure will be enjoyed by everyone. Please do remember that over the course of the first week, the KS1 pages on our school website will be updated and this will include key learning information and sources of support.

Homework

Please see the homework agreement on the website for suggested optional learning tasks that you and your child may wish to complete during the course of Term 2. Remember, these tasks are suggested ideas and we also welcome additional learning projects that children are inspired by. We do ask that projects and models do not come into school but would welcome photos, videos shared via Evidence Me. Consolidation activities using literacy and maths skills will also be sent out for Year 2 children over the course of the term.

Reading

Reading is hugely important and even more so in light of recent school closures. At Paulton Infant School we aim for all children to be read with by a Teacher or TA each week with the hope that this is more frequent where possible. Therefore, we ask that named book bags are in school every day to allow for reading opportunities to happen whenever possible.

Reading continued

Please continue to write in your child's reading record every time they read with you at home and remember we actively encourage rereading books and suggest that books should be read at least 3 times as this is proven to help reading development. Children will change books when they are reading the text with fluency and prosody which means sometimes children will keep a given book for increased periods.

P.E.Kits

PE sessions will continue as part of the school curriculum with each class having their own PE slots. PE sessions may take place inside or outside so please ensure that children have suitable footwear and clothing for outside games. We continue to ask that children have the correct kit for PE on their PE days. All PE kits should have a plain white or blue t shirt, dark plain shorts or joggers, socks, daps or trainers with each item named as well as the bag it is kept in. Class teachers will notify you of the specific PE days in due course if they haven't already done so.

Forest School and Wellies

Each class will have two terms of Forest School per school year. This term it is the turn for Hawthorn and Hazel and Holly classes. Please ensure your child has a pair of named wellies with them on their day and they come to school in their own clothes with their school uniform ready to change into.
