To sort and classify food into different food groups and understand the importance of a balanced diet

To understand the importance of exercise and perform simple tests to identify the effects exercise has on our bodies by gathering simple data

Counting: Count on and back in 2s, 5s and 10s.

Calculation: Multiplication and Division: Use 2x 5x 10 x facts for multiplication and division.

Record multiplication and division sentences using the correct symbols: x/÷/=

Number - Fractions: Use and find $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of shapes and amounts.

Measures - Time: Tell time to nearest quarter hour and begin to tell time to the nearest 5 minutes.
