- Write a letter from Willy Wonka inviting you to his factory!
- Research how your favourite sweets are made or where they come from
- Do a survey about favourite sweets of people you know and draw a simple chart to show this
- Create a sweet shop price list and decide how much you could buy for 10p? 20p? etc..
- Write a letter to Willy Wonka about a sweet idea you have.
- Any other idea you may have!
