

## Paulton Infant School Language of the Term

### Two year cycle 2020-22

Over their time at Paulton Infant school children will be exposed to 12 languages as part of our Language of the Term programme. As they attend our school for three years, this means they will be exposed to six of the languages twice. This provides opportunity to revisit their learning and build on their vocabulary.

The languages chosen both reflect the range of languages spoken by current pupils and their families and link to our topic learning where possible. We will review the Language of the Term Cycles regularly to ensure languages spoken reflect our school community and the topic cycles, therefore they are subject to change.
